Chapter 11: *Delighting in God's Word*

- Why did the Chinese woman memorize scripture when she was in prison (p. 166-167)? How does Ps. 119:11 relate to this idea?
- Are truth and understanding always the same? How does this relate to reading the Bible?
- Correcting back to the source. When the group leader says now, everyone write down the exact time on their watch hh:mm:ss (e.g. 07:35:23 is 7:35 p.m. and 23 seconds). How many people are in your group? How many different times do you have? How can you figure out which is the correct time?
- The Bible is God's truth recorded by people who were inspired by the Holy Spirit. What should be the standard or source of truth (the bureau of standards for spiritual truths if you will)? Why?
- What reasons does the author give in this chapter for why the Bible alone should be the standard for all truth?
- What are the consequences of not having or using one standard for truth? What do the following passages tell you about using a human source for truth (Job 14:4; James 3:11, Judges 17:6 and 21:25; NASB)?
- People around you in your world are looking for a truth standard. According to Matthew 5:14-16 and 5:48 what is your role? What standard must you use to fulfill this calling from God?
